


Our learning this half-term... - Year 3

English	Maths	Wider Curriculum
<p>In English this half term we will be learning about non-fiction and poetry texts.</p> <p>We will be learning about the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Features of a non-fiction and poetry text. • Language of a non-fiction and poetry text. • Choice of adventurous vocabulary to engage the reader. • Use of paragraphs and sub-headings to group together information in non-fiction texts. <p>To support your child with this aspect of learning you could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Share some non-fiction and poetry texts you may have at home. See if your child can identify the features. • Create a non-fiction text together about a topic of your choice. Emphasise the importance of including all of the non-fiction features i.e. sub-headings, titles, diagrams and captions. • Create a poem together about a topic of your choice. 	<p>In Maths this half term we will be covering the following skills:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Graphs: Reading and understanding them. Collecting data and creating own graphs. • Addition and Subtraction using the Column Method, including regrouping. • Addition and Subtraction Word Problems. • Adding and subtracting multiples of 10 and 100. • Area and Perimeter - metres, centimetres and millimetres. • Solving length word problems. • Multiplication and Division - Inverse relationships, Commutative law, solving missing number problems, solving a range of problems. <p>To help your child with this aspect of learning you could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practise addition and subtraction of two 3 digit numbers using the column method. • Counting in multiples of 10 and 100 from different numbers. • Practising times tables, consolidating 2, 5, 10 and 3s. Moving onto 4, 6 and 8. • Consolidating number bonds to 10, 20 and 100. • Application of maths in the real world - shopping, money, measuring. 	<p>Humanities</p> <p>In Humanities this half term, we will be learning about the History of Biggleswade. We will practise our timeline skills as well as learn about key dates in Biggleswade's history.</p> <p>Science</p> <p>In Science this half term, our learning is focussed on Scientists and Inventors. We will research famous scientists including Marie Curie and Inge Lehmann.</p> <p>PE</p> <p>Outdoor PE - (Please remember suitable clothing for PE outdoors!)</p> <p>Indoor PE - Gymnastics</p> <p>Ed for Life</p> <p>In Ed for Life this half term, we will be focussing on our Health and Wellbeing. Thinking about our achievements and personal goals, developing our understanding of conflict, feelings and how different behaviours can affect us. We will also be learning about how to get help in an emergency and some basic first aid.</p> <p>Computing</p> <p>Our learning in Computing this half term focuses on organising files and documents. Using Microsoft Word to insert text boxes, lines and shapes.</p> <p>Design Technology</p> <p>We will be continuing with designing and exploring packaging this half term.</p>
